Multi-University Campus Experience

Students will visit four internationally renowned universities — NYU Shanghai, Fudan University, Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University (XJTLU), and the University of Nottingham Ningbo China — gaining first-hand exposure to Sino-foreign academic models, dual-degree programmes, and student life in China. A rare opportunity to compare institutions and make informed decisions about higher education.

From the classical serenity of Yu Garden and the colonial grandeur of the Bund, to the soaring heights of Shanghai Tower (China's tallest building) and the bohemian charm of the Former French Concession — students experience the full spectrum of Shanghai's layered identity, making it one of the world's most compelling cities to explore.

Cross-City Journey Through the Yangtze River Delta

Travelling by high-speed rail through Suzhou and Ningbo, students experience China's world-class infrastructure first-hand. Each city adds a distinct flavour — Suzhou's ancient canals and silk heritage, Ningbo's modern energy — offering a broader picture of how China's regions are developing beyond its mega-cities.

1 (D)	Arrive in Shanghai and meet your WCE staff at the airport, who will support arrivals, logistics, and provide a smooth welcome to China’s most dynamic city. 2 (B, L, D)	Visit Yu Garden , a classical Ming-dynasty garden with ornate pavilions and koi ponds, then stroll along the Bund to admire the iconic contrast between colonial architecture and the Pudong skyline.	Visit NYU Shanghai for a guided campus tour and information session. As the first Sino-US research university in China, it offers a truly global academic environment.	Ascend Shanghai Tower at 632 m, China's tallest building — and enjoy breathtaking 360° panoramic views from the 118th-floor observation deck at dusk. Overnight in Shanghai
3 (B, L, D)	Visit Fudan University , one of China's most prestigious institutions founded in 1905. Enjoy a guided campus tour and session with faculty covering academic programmes and research opportunities.	Spend the afternoon at Shanghai Wild Animal Park , home to over 200 species including giant pandas, white tigers, and African lions — a fun and memorable experience for the whole group.	Free evening to explore the hotel neighbourhood, rest, and recharge for the journey to Suzhou tomorrow. Overnight in Shanghai

4 (B, L, D)	Drive to Suzhou (~1.5 hrs) — the " Venice of the East ". Arrive at Shantang Jie , a beautifully preserved ancient street lined with whitewashed buildings and teahouses. Enjoy lunch here, sampling squirrel-shaped mandarin fish and osmanthus cake.	Visit Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University (XJTLU) , a unique Sino-British joint venture offering degrees from both XJTLU and the University of Liverpool. Attend a campus tour and session on the dual-degree model and career outcomes.	Free time on Pingjiang Lu , one of Suzhou's most charming historic canal-side streets. Browse boutiques, sample street food, or simply soak up the atmosphere. Overnight in Suzhou
5 (B, L, D)	Board the high-speed train from Suzhou to Ningbo (~2 hrs), travelling at up to 350 km/h through the scenic Yangtze River Delta — a quintessential modern China experience.	Visit University of Nottingham Ningbo China (UNNC) — the first Sino-foreign university in China, established in 2004. The campus mirrors Nottingham's UK campus and delivers a fully English-language education. Meet staff and students to explore programmes and scholarships.	Head to Tianyi Square , Ningbo's vibrant commercial and dining hub. Choose from a wide variety of local and international restaurants for a lively evening out. Overnight in Ningbo

6 (B, L, D)	Take the high-speed train back to Shanghai (~2 hrs). Arrive refreshed and ready for a final afternoon of cultural exploration in one of Shanghai's most atmospheric neighbourhoods.	Explore the Former French Concession — tree-lined avenues, Art Deco mansions, and independent cafés — then visit the Propaganda Poster Art Museum , a hidden gem with original Chinese political posters from the 1950s–1980s.	Browse Tianzifang , a creative arts enclave in a maze of traditional shikumen alleyways. Pick up unique souvenirs, local artwork, handmade jewellery, and specialty teas. Overnight in Shanghai
7 (B)	Enjoy a final breakfast at the hotel.	Transfer to Shanghai Hongqiao Airport. <i>[Suggested routing: Air China CA1508 → Air China CA799 Depart Shanghai Hongqiao (SHA): 11:30 Transfer in Beijing (PEK): ~4 hrs 10 min Arrive Almaty (ALA): 20:30]</i>	

NYU Shanghai

Location: Shanghai | **Type:** Sino-American Research University

Founded in 2013, NYU Shanghai is the first Sino-US research university in China and a full member of the NYU Global Network. It offers a rigorous liberal arts and sciences education entirely in English, with a student body drawn from over 80 countries. Students graduate with a degree from both NYU Shanghai and New York University, making it one of the most globally recognised institutions in Asia.



Fudan University

Location: Shanghai | **Type:** National Research University

One of China's most prestigious and selective universities, Fudan was founded in 1905 and is consistently ranked among the top universities in Asia. Located in the heart of Shanghai, it offers a wide range of programmes across humanities, sciences, medicine, and business. Fudan is known for its strong research output, vibrant campus culture, and deep connections to China's intellectual and political history.



Xi'an Jiaotong-Liverpool University (XJTLU)

Location: Suzhou | **Type:** Sino-British Joint Venture University

Established in 2006 as a partnership between Xi'an Jiaotong University and the University of Liverpool, XJTLU is one of China's leading international universities. Students study in English and can earn a University of Liverpool degree upon completion. The university places a strong emphasis on research, entrepreneurship, and preparing graduates for a globalised workforce.



University of Nottingham Ningbo China (UNNC)

Location: Ningbo | **Type:** Sino-British Joint Venture University

Opened in 2004, UNNC was the **first Sino-foreign university in China**, established as a partnership between the University of Nottingham (UK) and Zhejiang Wanli Education Group. The campus is modelled on Nottingham's UK campus and delivers a fully English-language curriculum. Graduates receive a University of Nottingham degree, recognised worldwide, making UNNC a popular choice for students seeking a British education in China.

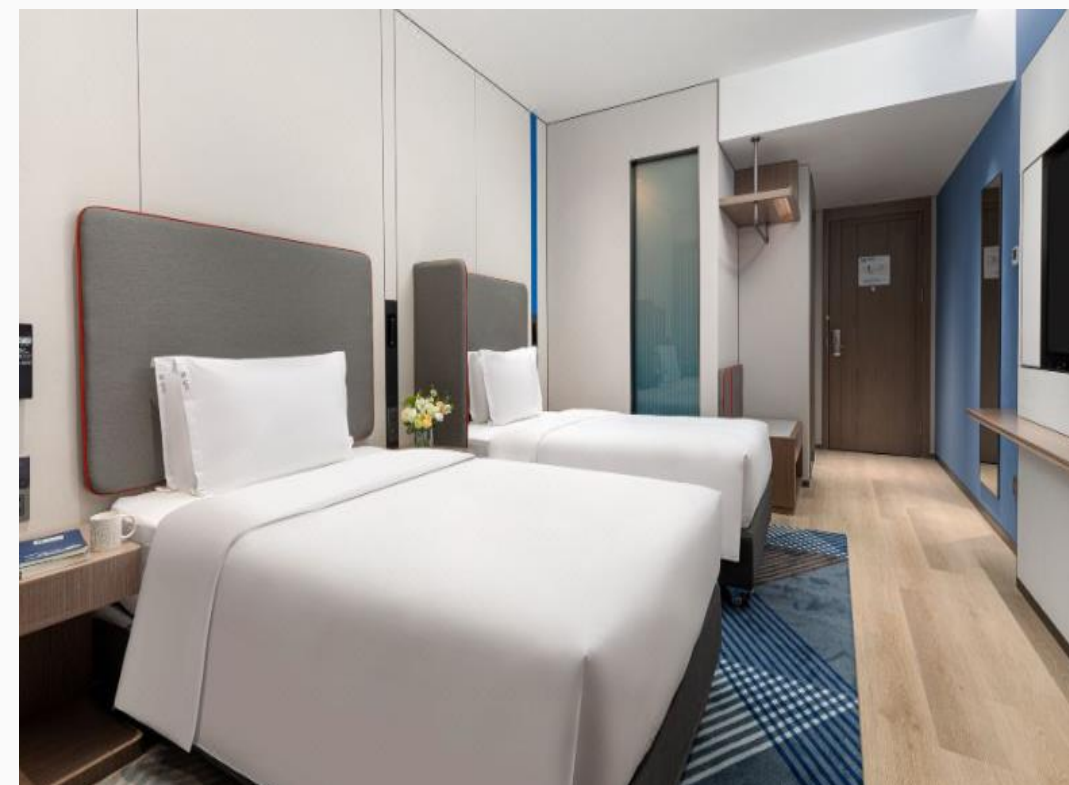
